

101 East 110 South Exit on Exposition Blvd, go straight. Turn right on Figueroa. Left on Jefferson Blvd. (Shrine 1/2 block on Right) From the 10 (East and Westbound, Santa Monica Freeway)

Exit Hoover, go south. Turn left on 32nd Street. (Shrine 1 1/2 blocks on right side)

**From the 110 (North Harbor Freeway)** Exit Adams Left turn Turn Left on Figueroa Turn Right on Jefferson (Shrine 1/2 block on Right)

From the 110 (South Harbor Freeway) Exit Exposition Blvd right turn. Turn right on Figueroa.
